

Unfortunately, today more and more people find it increasingly difficult to engage in texts that are longer than a Tweet.

Literature threatens to become a minority program.

So we start where everyone starts: as listeners ...

If parents or teachers had not read to us, we would never have become readers.





The goal


With the Austrian Reading Day, we want to set a clear signal for the reading of literary texts and for the book as a medium.

Our ambition is to turn the Austrian Reading Day into a national movement for reading books.

The project team has set itself the goal of having the Austrian Reading Day in all 2,100 municipalities in Austria by 2020.

The participants organize readings wherever they want:

... in kindergartens, schools, offices, coffee houses, restaurants, hotel lobby's, hospitals, gymnasiums but also in living rooms, cable car gondolas, workshops, ...

The imagination knows no limits.

Everyone who participates, reads texts of their choice or from our specially designed lecture book.



Who participates?



Everyone is allowed to participate and to organize readings.

- the action is understood as non-partisan
- representatives of the people are invited to participate.
- every organization can register to read aloud.

All people who want to share their enthusiasm for reading with others are invited.

There is no age limit.

As a suggestion for the readers, a Lecture Book is produced exclusively for the AUSTRIAN READING DAY every year.

The texts are a selection of renowned authors and put together so that there is something for every age group.

Each reader will receive their personalized Lecture Book by mail before the Austrian Reading Day.



The social benefits



The book can be bought in stores and at the readings.

The proceeds from the sale go to UNICEF, the aid organization dedicated to the promotion of children.

If children lack the bare necessities, any chance for education is a chance for a better life.
